- Fixed fee for making a simple will: £85 for an individual or £130 for a couple plus VAT.
- Fixed fees for making a simple Power of Attorney: £85 plus VAT for an individual or £105 plus VAT for a couple. If a Power of Attorney is registered with the Public Guardian, the fees will be £155 plus VAT for an individual and £180 plus VAT for a couple. Power of Attorney fees are exclusive of the Public Guardian's registration charges.
- Discount of 5% (£250 maximum) on the winding up of the estate of the employee, or his/her spouse or resident partner, parents and grandparents.

Property

- Discount of 10% off standard estate agency fee subject to a minimum fee of £850 plus VAT and outlays.
- Discount of 10% off standard home sales conveyancing fees subject to a minimum fee, net of discount, of £600 plus VAT and outlays.
- Discount of 10% off standard home purchase conveyancing fees subject to a minimum fee, net of discount, of £600 plus VAT and outlays.
